**New Business:**

**WorkOne Staff Attending National Association of Workforce Development Professionals (NAWDP) Conference**

Three WorkOne staff, Treva Nichols, Maritsa Avila, and Danielle Purnell will attend the upcoming NAWDP Conference in Pheonix, Arizona. This is a training opportunity to skill up the WorkOne staff and earn a workforce development certification as a counselor.

**Jobs for America's Graduates (JAG) Career Development Conference (CDC)**

The JAG CDC will be held February 6, 2025, on the campus of Ivy Tech Lafayette. The back-up date is February 13<sup>th</sup>. Ethan Groff, JAG Manager and Sara Snowden, Assistant JAG Manager, are looking for volunteers to judge the competition events. We estimate over 300-350 JAG students will be participating or attending. The event includes competitions, a career fair, campus tour, guest speaker on leadership, lunch and award ceremony. JAG 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students from Benton Central will also attend. Kara requested to include the Career + schools and register the participants to conduct a survey following the event.

**Jobs for America's Graduates (JAG) Expansion**

There are three additional schools starting the JAG program in January 2025. Tipton and Lewis Cass will add 11-12 classes, Twin Lakes School in Monticello is adding a 9-10 class. Logansport Academy in starting a class. Region 4 is in 9 of 12 of our counties.

**New WIOA Performance Goals for Youth**

Region 4 re-negotiated the WIOA Performance goals for Youth for PY 24 and PY 25. PY 24 will remain the same. PY 25 the goal for Employment after 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter and the goal for Employment after 4<sup>th</sup> quarter will increase. We believe Region 4 will be able to meet the new performance goals.

## Committee Member Updates

- **Terri Simons** announced her new role as Director of Operations with TAP/Region 4 Workforce Board beginning November 18, 2024.
- **Greater Lafayette Career Academy (GLAC)** enrollment increased 31% and are recruiting for next school year. GLAC has a pilot program with Right Steps Child Care and the pre-apprenticeship program through the Dept, of Education. Miranda Hutcheson shared information about the dual- credits, pre-apprenticeship and the pathways of the program.
- **Greater Lafayette Commerce**
  - Manufacturing Week-Over 1600 students participated in Manufacturing Week. Registration is open for next year. Next year will be open to 400 elementary students and 400 middle school students.
  - Kara attended the Manufacturing Workforce Summit in Minnesota
  - Met with employers about work-based learning, new graduation requirements, and graduation seals.
  - Visit to SK hynix - Kara shared her trip to Korea. A group of partners toured the SK hynix facility. Discussion was had about how to begin moving forward to spark interest and training in the industry sector.
